Medals will be awarded for First, Second and Third place in each category. Awards Awards will be made based on the highest scoring SINGLE ROUNDS All competitors must comply with Archery GB dress regulations (see rule 307) Any archer not complying with these regulations will not be permitted to shoot. Dress See Archery GB Rules of Shooting Rule 307 for detsils Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to provide samples must comply. **Drug Testing** Failure to do so will be treated as a positive result. Parents/Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry form to give consent for under 18s to be drug tested if approached Refreshments will be available throughout the day from the Supermarine catering tent Refreshments Photography Anyone wishing to take photos or video at the event must sign the register first Please park in Supermarine Bowmen's lower field. Do not park on the grass by the shooting Car Parking field or obstrust any gateways or pathways.

Lost Arrows	The venue is a sports playing field and all arrows MUST be accounted for. All lost arrows must be reported to a judge. It is the archer's responsibility to locate any missed arrows before leaving the field. If you intend to shoot all carbon arrows, you must indicate with your entry how you intend to find them should you miss the target.
Dogs	No dogs are permitted on the premises.
Smoking	Smoking: If you need to smoke, please do so in the clear area behind the catering tent. This includes E-cigarettes
